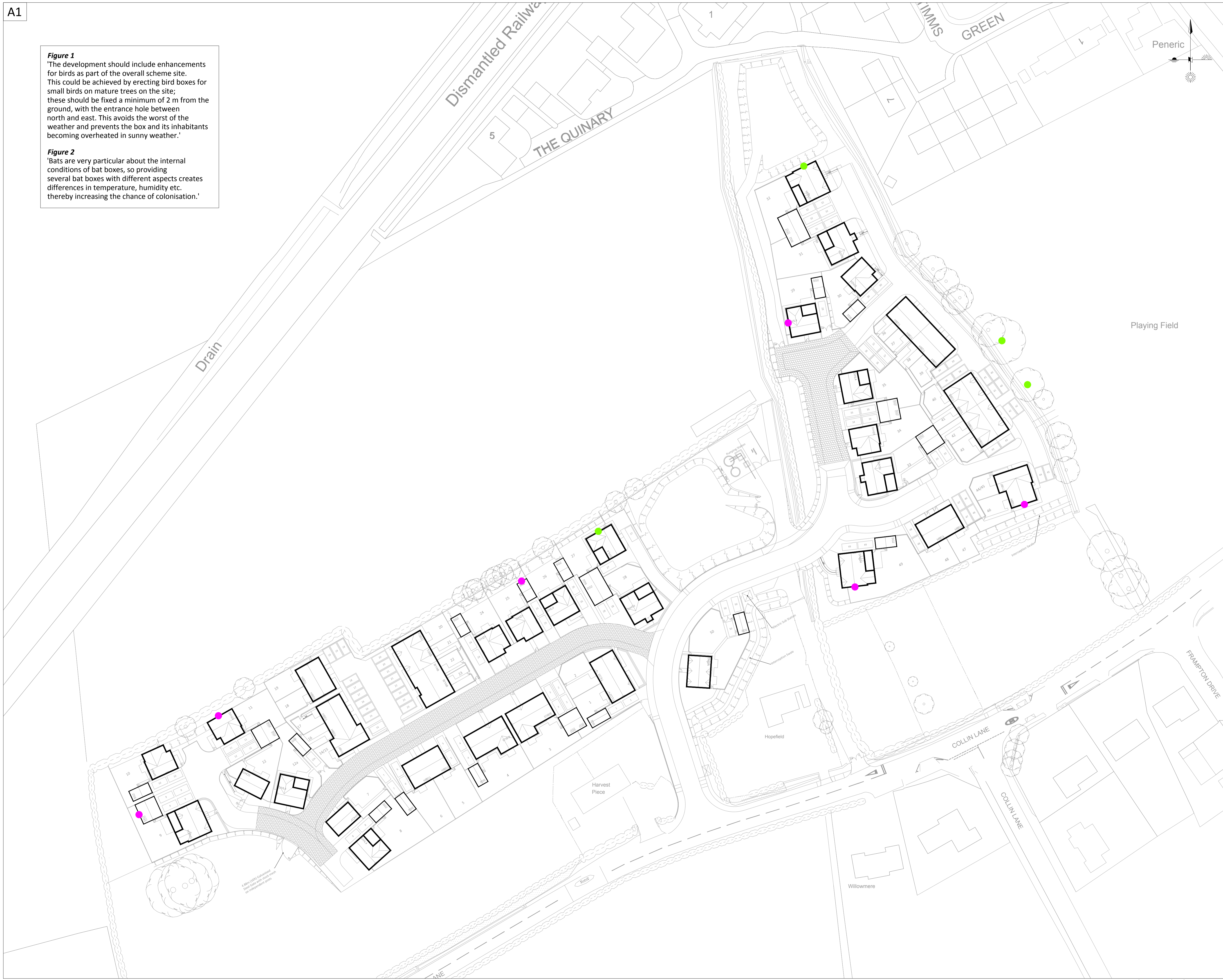

 'The development should include enhancements for birds as part of the overall scheme site. This could be achieved by erecting bird boxes for small birds on mature trees on the site; these should be fixed a minimum of 2 m from the ground, with the entrance hole between north and east. This avoids the worst of the weather and prevents the box and its inhabitants becoming overheated in sunny weather.'

 'Bats are very particular about the internal conditions of bat boxes, so providing several bat boxes with different aspects creates differences in temperature, humidity etc. thereby increasing the chance of colonisation.'
