

WILLERSEY HORTICULTURAL SHOW HISTORY

The inspiration of setting up the Willersey Horticultural Show was led by Eric Beadle. Previously Eric had experience of running Horticultural Shows in nearby Broadway. The first Willersey Show was held in 2007.

The founding members were Eric Beadle, Sandy Barnes, Gillian Beale, Richard Ingles and Jenny Bond.


After the first Horticultural Show in 2007, Eric unfortunately became ill and sadly passed away. In 2008 Bill Payne was asked to become Chairman. The Eric Beadle cup was then created in Eric's memory and awarded to the overall Champion of the Show.

As the Show evolved during the preceding years, the Dog Show and numerous other Village attractions joined in on the day.

Bill continued to run the Show with the help of many others up to 2019 after which the Covid Pandemic put things on hold for two years. A new Committee was formed as the Village emerged from the Lockdown period and the Show morphed into what you see today.

RULES

- 1. Exhibitors cannot enter more than one exhibit in each category. Each exhibitor must use a SEPARATE ENTRY FORM.
- 2. Entries of fruit, vegetables and flowers must be the exhibitor's own grown produce. In all other classes the exhibit must be the exhibitor's own work.
- 3. Unless stipulated otherwise any age person can enter any class.
- 4. Any exhibitor infringing these rules will be disqualified. Any dispute arising shall be settled by the Committee and their decision shall be final.
- 5. The decision of the Judges will be final.
- 6. The Committee cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits or personal property.
- 7. **ENTRY FEES**: 25p per category (Children's Classes are FREE!)
- 8. ENTRY FORMS AND FEES, in a sealed envelope, must be submitted to the Willersey Parish Council post box (side of Village Hall), NO LATER THAN 5.00pm ON WEDNESDAY 21st AUGUST 2024
- 9 All entries to be brought to the Village Hall, on the Show Day, between 9.30 am and 10.30 am. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 10.30 am. Judging will take place between 11am and 12 noon.
- 10. On Show Day each exhibitor will be given an envelope containing a ticket for each category entered. Each ticket will show class letter, category number and individual exhibitor number, and are to be placed with your exhibit. No names must be added until after the judging is completed.
- 11. NO EXHIBIT MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE CLOSE OF SHOW AT 5pm. ALL EXHIBITS TO BE REMOVED BEFORE 6 pm.
- 12. NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE VILLAGE HALL (with the exception of assistance dogs) as per the Village Hall policy.

Entries are welcome from allcomers, however, the Eric Beadle Cup will only be awarded to a Willersey resident using points won from all Categories except J & K.



J MEN'S CATEGORY SHOW CAKE

Apricot Fruit Loaf (makes 1 x 2lb cake)

Ingredients

75g Glace cherries.

175g Self-Raising flour.

100g Soft margarine.

100g Light brown sugar.

100g Ready to eat dried apricots.

150g Sultanas.

3 size 2 Eggs.

Method

Oven 160°c or gas mark 3

Base line 2lb / 900g loaf tin or use liner.

Cut cherries into half, wash and dry on kitchen paper.

Chop apricots.

Put margarine and sugar into mixing bowl and cream together.

Add eggs and flour, apricots and sultanas, Mix well until smooth.

Stir in cherries turn mixture into tin and smooth top.

Bake in oven 55 mins until firm to touch and a fine skewer comes out clean.

Cool in the tin for ten minutes turn out onto wire rack to cool completely.

Remember all ovens are different so it may take a little longer.

CATEGORY K: Children's Section: Ideas & Examples

Class (1): 5 years and younger



Using natural material such as twigs, leaves, plant seeds, flower heads, petals etc make a collage picture of a tree on A4 card. NOTE – It may be necessary to laminate your design to ensure that the natural materials are not damaged.

Class (2): 6 years/ 7 years



Find a stick which is no longer than 30cm and no wider than 5cm. Transform your stick by shaving off the bark at one end to create a fun face using any material of your choice.

Class (3): 8 years/9 years



Cover a clean tin can (approximately 11cm tall and 8 cm in diameter) with twigs to create a container. Fill your container with a beautiful display of dried or long-lasting evergreen plants.

Class (4): 10 years/ 11 years



Create a design or picture on a tree slice. The tree slice should be no more than 20cm in diameter and 3cm in thickness.

Exhibitors are requested to name varieties where known. Extra points will be awarded for uniform produce.

CHILDRENS CLASSES All entries must be the entrant's own work. Age group on 1st September 2023 to 31st August 2024.

VEGETABLES AND FRUIT:

Assorted vegetables – 5 different vegetables of your choice on a tray.

Courgettes - with flowers on will be awarded extra points.

Tomatoes - with stalks on will be awarded extra point. Do not display on the truss.

Exotic fruit – display one of your choice from melon, cape gooseberries, figs, orange, lemon or bunch of grapes or other exotic fruit on a paper plate.

PRESERVES:

Chutney & Savory Jam - in a glass jar with a new vinegar resistant lid and including the date it was made.

COOKERY:

Chocolate Sponge - butter cream filling on a china plate. No doyley. Show Cake - on a china plate. No doyley. Judging is based on the flavour, shape, uniformity and texture of the cake.
