

## Willersey Stores Closure - Newspapers

The shop closed on Saturday October 10<sup>th</sup> 2020 and with it the availability of daily newspapers. For some years Shopwright of Broadway have delivered pre-ordered newspapers to a central location in local villages e.g. Buckland, Laverton, Stanton etc. for customers to collect. They will also administer any subscription (tokens) arrangements that you have set up with a newspaper. Arrangements have been made with **The New Inn** for them to be the central point for collection (at the porch near the outside tables) from Monday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>. There is an additional charge for this service depending on your requirements as follow:

Monday to Saturday £2.10 per week

Monday to Sunday £3.10 per week

Occasional Day £1.70 per day

To participate you have to contact Shopwright on 01386 853478 and establish your order and payment arrangement. Your newspaper will be available at the central collection point from 8 a.m. and throughout the day. It will be identified to you by surname and you may cancel or change your order at any time by contacting Shopwright.

Whilst the process is more or less 'self managed' if you have any queries at this stage please contact Alan (858601) or Bill (858628) who have made the arrangements. We are grateful to both the Parish Council for funding the printing of this leaflet and the volunteers who have delivered it and of course The New Inn for acting as the collection point.

Also, please note that **The New Inn** will be open from 10.a.m. Tuesday to Sunday serving breakfasts, coffee and cakes.

Shopwright will ask for a deposit of £50. You will pay for your papers monthly after receiving them. The deposit is to cover them for debts they have experienced in the past. The deposit will be refunded in full if you leave the arrangement and your payments are up to date. Any unclaimed papers will be collected the following morning when the next delivery is made.
