REPORTING ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR TO THE POLICE

IN COMPLETE CONFIDENCE

Unfortunately the Parish Council is not able to make reports to the police on behalf of residents.

BUT if you telephone **101** you can report <u>any</u> incident you feel is important no matter how insignificant it may seem, but you should know that:

THE POLICE ARE BOUND BY THE CONFINES OF THE CONSTABULARY; THEY WILL **NOT** TELL ANYONE WHO HAS MADE THE REPORT. **NO ONE** WILL FIND OUT YOUR NAME OR ADDRESS. THEY WILL TAKE YOU SERIOUSLY

When you leave your name it carries more weight to your complaint and the police are more able to do something about the situation. An antisocial behaviour situation will often need several reports to enable the police to build a case and act, so please keep reporting, and encourage others to do the same.

If you do not report incidents yourself you loose the right to complain.

So please, help the village by reporting any antisocial behaviour to the police on **101**.
